We are asking you to help us sell boxes of greeting cards to your friends, family, and community. This fundraiser is well loved and respected around the nation. Once you see the quality of these greeting cards and boxes, that will come as no surprise! These are greetings cards your friends and family will want in their homes and look to purchase time and time again.

You will have the opportunity to see the greeting card boxes in person at our Colt Stampede event October 25<sup>th</sup>. Students will receive an order form, social media toolkit, and other promotional materials to support their sales.

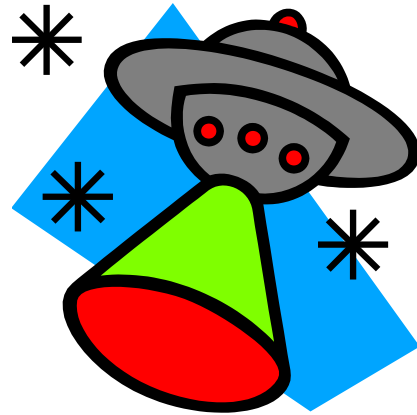

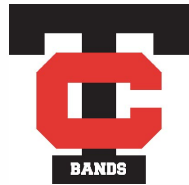
