

Troy Colt Bands CONCERT SEASON UNIFORM DRESS CODE AND GUIDELINES

Troy High Bands take great pride in their public image, and appearance is a key factor. Proper uniform wear and care is mandatory. All uniforms must be clean and in good repair for every performance.

Students are provided

Females: Concert Dress

Males: Tuxedo jacket, tuxedo pants, cummerbund and bow tie

Students are responsible to provide

Females: 1.) Black closed-toe dress shoes (1-2" heel)

2.) Black hosiery

Males: 1.) Black leather shoes and black socks

2.) White tuxedo shirt—Specifications: winged tip collar, button closure (no "studs" substitution), with pleated front (1/4 inch pleats)

To purchase:

Bring a \$16 check to uniform distribution (payable to THS Band Boosters). A clerk from The Tux Shop
on Woodward will size you for a shirt and place the order. Shirts that are ordered by The Tux Shop
representative will be distributed prior to the first concert.

Alterations

Alterations to tuxedos and dresses (including hemming) will be provided by the tailor who will be present at uniform distribution. Altered items will be distributed prior to the first concert.

Cleaning/Mending

All tuxedos must be dry cleaned—please do not wash.

Our discount dry cleaner is Earl Cleaners, at 555 N. Rochester Road, Clawson, 248.589.1819.

Earl Cleaners also offers repair services by a master tailor (George). Please mention that you are a THS Band member.

Concert dresses are washable.

Please follow the care instructions attached to the garment. Dresses will be dry cleaned at the end of the season.

Reminders:

Female members are required to wear hair up in a formal bun and off the face – all hair accessories must be black. Male members must have Tuxedo shirts washed and pressed before each concert.
