Form 3 - MB Performance Schedule/Contract

Additional performances may be added and changes may occur. **All band performances are mandatory**. Students are notified of performance commitments early enough to arrange their schedules accordingly. If you know there is an unavoidable conflict in your schedule, please make a note on the contract form. <u>Unexcused absences will impact the student's grade and class standing.</u>

Form 4 – Band Camp and Uniform Fees

Please mark which uniform items are needed and add cost to your camp deposit and fees check.

Form 5 & 6 – Health and Delegation to Treat

Michigan law requires that these forms be completed every year for each marching band student. A parent or quardian, along with another adult witness, must sign the Delegation to Treat Form.

These forms are taken to camp and on all band trips. In an emergency, an effort is made to contact the parents first. If parents cannot be reached, the emergency contact person is called. The emergency contact should be someone other than a parent. Please list a grandparent, aunt, uncle, close friend or someone whom you trust to assist your child during a health emergency. Returning members must fill out new forms each year.

Form 7 – Post-Band Camp Student Release Authorization

The State of Michigan requires that campers (students) are released only to authorized persons at the end of camp. Given the administrative difficulties of releasing each camper to the authorized parent or legal guardian in a timely manner, we ask that parents acknowledge their obligation to meet their camper at Troy High School after camp. This action thereby releases the Director of the Bands or his representatives, to check the identification of the persons to whom their camper is released.
